Footnotes

BUSH TRIUMPH bobbled slightly at the start, stalked a bit off the rail, bid outside the runner-up leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch and drew clear under a brisk hand ride. NUIT DE SIAM (FR) between horses early, stalked off the rail then bid outside the early leader, gained the advantage leaving the backstretch, inched clear on the second turn, was no match for the winner in the stretch but clearly second best. BELLA VOLARE four wide into the first turn, chased outside a rival, angled in on the second turn and bested the others. BYE BYE BIRDIE pulled her way to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail on the backstretch and into the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. MUSCHI saved ground off the pace without early speed and did not rally. FANCY BEGINING three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail and weakened.
