Footnotes

IRISH EXPRESS had good early speed off the rail then angled in and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch and held gamely under urging. LADY DISDAIN (GB) prompted the pace three deep, fell back some into the stretch and was coming back at the winner late. EARLY ANNA bumped at the start, chased outside then three deep, angled in outside a rival nearing the stretch, split horses in midstretch and gained the show, then returned bleeding in the mouth. ANNIE OAKLEAF bumped between horses at the start, chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. ABBEY CAT (IRE) a bit slow to begin, chased a bit off the rail then between foes, continued inside on the turn and into the stretch, came out in the drive and did not rally. COMPANY SECRET hopped then bobbed slightly in a bit of a slow start, pulled her way along off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. HELMSGOLD broke in and bumped a rival, dueled between horses then outside the winner into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MEG'S OPERATOR settled a bit off the aril, came out in the stretch and was not a factor. LOST MEMO chased inside, dropped back into and on the turn and gave way.
