CANYON DRIVE chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead past the eighth pole and pulled clear under urging. SHIHAAB settled outside then alongside a rival, also came four wide into the stretch and was clearly second best. PHANTOM WILDCAT went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted in under right handed pressure in midstretch, weakened and narrowly edged a rival for third. LUCIUS ANTONIUS stalked outside then bid four wide on the backstretch, took back and angled to the inside into the turn, continued inside in the stretch, steadied in tight along the fence in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. CAJUN CORREDOR stalked off the rail then bid three deep between foes on the backstretch, continued three wide into the turn then outside a foe and weakened in the stretch. EON broke a bit slowly and bobbed slightly in the opening strides, settled inside, came out in midstretch and split foes late. ROYAL SEAL broke slowly, trailed a bit off the rail, also came out in the stretch and lacked the needed response. VOODOO KING dueled between horses then stalked a bit off the rail on the turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and gave way. Following a stewards' inquiry, PHANTOM WILDCAT was disqualified and placed fourth for interference in midstretch.
