**Footnotes**

OCTANE moved up on the inside to take the early lead, dueled on the inside to the stretch, resisted when challenged in midstretch, drifted out through the final furlong and held on. SEQUOIA WARRIOR stalked outside the dueling pacesetters down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the lane three wide, bid three deep in midstretch, went willingly to the wire but could not get past the winner. ROYAL MERIDIAN dueled for the lead on the outside down the backstretch, came into the stretch between horses, bid for command between foes in midstretch and gradually weakened in the final furlong. MOROCCAN SKY chased on the outside down the backstretch and three deep on the turn, angled in at the top of the lane and failed to mount the necessary rally. BEV N BUD chased off the rail down the backstretch and between horses on the turn, remained outside in the lane and weakened. IN HIGH REGARDS broke a bit slowly, chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, remained on the wood in the lane and was without a rally.
