Footnotes

PLATINUM MINE chased off the rail then inside on the hill, came out in upper stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead three wide in deep stretch and proved best. THREE CUTIES stalked three deep or off the rail, continued three wide leaving the hill, bid between horses in late stretch and continued willingly but could not quite match the winner. ELUSIVE SPIRIT sped to the early lead, inched away inside on the hill, kicked clear, held on well to deep stretch then could not match strides with the top pair but held third. HUNTINGTON HARBOUR saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail late and lacked the needed response. WARREN'S HOPEFUL stalked between horses or outside a rival, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. BABENEAU had speed outside a rival then stalked that one just off the rail to the stretch and weakened. STORMY ANNA settled off the inside, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. JOEY LA BAMBA dropped back off the rail, angled in some on the hill, found the fence in the stretch and was outrun. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
