Footnotes

MIND THE MASTER stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, bid three deep a quarter mile out, gained the lead, angled in entering the stretch and won clear under left handed urging. WARREN'S BIG CAT settled outside a rival chasing the pace, split horses twice in the stretch and gained the place. ANYTHINGS COOKIN had good early speed and drifted out into the first turn, angled in and dueled inside, fought back to a short lead leaving the second turn, weakened in the stretch but held third. OUR BOY BENJAMIN fanned out some into the first turn, chased outside or alongside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. UNREMITTING tugged between horses, chased outside a rival then inside on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. SANIBEL SID saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. WARREN'S JEFF G. pulled between horses and steadied into the first turn, settled

outside a rival chasing the pace to the stretch and did not rally. ERBEIA a bit slow to begin, angled in just off the rail then inside, went between horses on the second turn and was not a threat. HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS settled along the inside off the pace, came out some on the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. ME LIKEY MIKEY fanned four wide into the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. PAPA LEV had speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, drifted out some into the backstretch, battled outside a foe then between horses leaving the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and gave way.
