BIG MACHER stalked between horses then bid three deep between foes into and on the turn and into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive, put a head in front nearing the sixteenth pole and gamely prevailed under urging. WILD DUDE chased three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly to just miss. CYCLOMETER stalked outside foes then bid four wide into and on the turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage outside the winner nearing midstretch, fought back between foes in deep stretch and continued gamely to best the rest. MIDNIGHT TRANSFER chased between rivals early then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and had a mild late bid. WINE POLICE stalked just off the rail then bid between horses into and on the turn, continued just off the fence into the stretch, drifted in and weakened in the final furlong. ZEEWAT chased just off the inside then along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CRIMSON GIANT allowed to settle off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. MONGOLIAN SATURDAY was sent along inside to the early lead, dueled along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and gave way.
