LEMON HERO had speed off the inside then relinquished command and stalked off the fence, came three deep into the stretch and finished willingly under left handed urging to get up nearing the wire. SWEET NECTAR a bit slow into stride, was sent along inside and dueled from the rail, inched away on the turn, drifted out in the stretch and was caught in the final strides. MY DIANE broke in the air and slowly, angled in and chased inside throughout and edged a rival for the show. ONE BAD TEXTER had good early speed and dueled outside the runner-up, stalked just off the fence on the turn and into the stretch and weakened but was edged for third. DUSTIN'S MAGIC settled outside a rival then chased off the rail to the stretch and lacked a response in the drive.
