UNUSUAL BEAM chased off the inside, came three wide into the stretch and closed willingly under urging to get up nearing the wire. JOHNNY BE MINE angled in and dueled outside a rival, gained a slim advantage in the stretch, inched away from his pace rival in deep stretch but was caught late. URBAN HUNTER had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back leaving the hill and through the stretch, weakened some in the final stages but held third. TURN ON THE PUMPS three deep early, chased just off the rail then angled in on the hill, cut the corner into the stretch, continued inside then split foes on the line. DIXIELAND BLUES saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in upper stretch, drifted in some in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. WARRENS WILD THING unhurried off the rail down the hill, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. POCKET PRINCE saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. RED MAN RUN hopped slightly then bobbed some at the start, pulld his way between horses then chased outside a rival, came out in the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
