GOLDEN BALLS (IRE) saved ground off the pace, moved up leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and closed willingly under left handed urging to get up on the wire. DESERT CODE pulled his way to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, inched away again into the stretch and held on gamely but was caught late. VAUQUELIN (IRE) close up stalking the pace inside, came out in midstretch and continued willingly. VAUNT (GB) chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHEM stalked outside a rival then bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch and dueled for the lead to the stretch, then weakened. STAR INSIDE (IRE) chased a bit off the rail then inside, continued along the fence in the stretch and did not rally. STREETS AHEAD (GB) broke slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and failed to menace.
