Footnotes

STICKY CANDY settled outside a rival, split horses on the backstretch and chased between foes, bid alongside the leader in the stretch, took the advantage past the eighth pole and won clear under some left handed urging. ROOS ON THE LOOSE stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and was second best. SPEEDY MARINI had good early speed off the rail, dueled outside a rival, put a head in front leaving the turn, fought back toward the inside in midstretch and held third. JOHNNIE GOLD broke inward and a bit slowly, went up inside to chase the pace, was shuffled back a bit just past midway on the turn, continued along the rail into the stretch and bested the others. GUADALUPE LUPE stalked outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. BOSTON BAKED BEAN dropped back outside then settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. DR. TONG went up inside a rival to duel for the lead just off the inside, angled in some on the turn and weakened in the stretch. JENARY JOE chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and turn and gave way in the stretch.
