Footnotes

BUYER'S REMORSE settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, surged to the front, drifted in and proved best under urging. FORTHREEFORUCLID wide early, angled in outside a rival, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, split rivals in the drive, also drifted in and fought back inside the winner but could not match that one late. GILLIGAN broke out a bit, angled in and settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, split rivals in upper stretch, angled back in and picked up the show. REALLY UPTOWN came off the rail on the first turn to chase the pace, angled three deep into the stretch, was in tight off heels in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. QUILLTANO angled in and settled outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and improved position. CALIFORNIA COLONEL allowed to settle off the pace alongside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PRECIOUS DUKE dueled outside a rival, inched away leaving the backstretch, kicked clear toward the inside, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. COO CACHOO stalked just off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the second turn and into the stretch, steadied off heels in midstretch and also weakened. STRAIGHTOMIDNIGHT squeezed a bit at the start, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. FIRE IN THE WIND had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked along the rail into and on the second turn, then weakened. BRADIO STATION squeezed a bit at the start, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a factor.
