**CALLED TO SERVE** pulled his way along inside and steadied in the run to the first turn, went outside a rival to chase on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch, shifted in a bit while moving up in midstretch, rallied to the front outside foes under urging a sixteenth out and proved best. **MY SAMURAI WARRIOR** between foes early, chased outside a rival on the first turn then along the inside on the backstretch and second turn and went up the rail in late stretch for the place. **SEAL THE DEAL** close up stalking the pace inside, came out in upper stretch, was between horses past midstretch and three deep a sixteenth out and was edged for the place. **EATON HALL** tugged his way to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail, was between horses past midstretch and weakened. **HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS** broke a bit slowly, went up three deep then stalked outside a rival, dropped back some in upper stretch, steadied when crowded a furlong out and also weakened. **MY SAMURAI WARRIOR** and **HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS** wore calks.
