Footnotes

TOLEDO EDDIE dueled for the early lead four deep, took command into the turn, inched clear on the turn and drew away in the final furlong under steady hand urging and a long hold late. DOMONATION chased outside a foe on the backstretch, moved up three wide on the turn, came into the stretch three deep, battled four deep in midstretch, did not threaten the winner but held the place. SUPERCABRAS dueled between horses on the backstretch, eased back when in a bit tight approaching the turn, saved ground around the turn, rallied inside through the final furlong and was edged for the show. TOTAL BULL dueled three deep in the early going and between horses into the turn, came into the stretch between foes, drifted out through the final furlong and weakened. CHINESE PRAISE chased inside a foe on the backstretch, angled towards the rail into the turn, came back out for the drive and did not mount the necessary rally. FLOWER POWER dueled for the lead on the inside down the backstretch, could not go with the winner on the turn and weakened between horses in the lane.
