Footnotes

JETS TO BRAZIL chased off the rail then angled in on the hill, came out a bit in upper stretch, bid alongside the leader past the eighth pole, gained a short advantage past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. BUCKLEBERRY GREY chased outside then went between horses leaving the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. MAXX THE GIANT was in a good position chasing the pace between horses then angled to the inside, cut the corner into the stretch, moved up inside in the drive then split foes on the wire. HORIZONTALYSPEAKIN dueled four wide then stalked outside, went three deep leaving the hill and into the stretch and also finished well. HEAT FLASH dropped back outside then off the rail, angled in on the hill, came out in upper

stretch and found his best stride late. CHANGE OF PLAN sent inside to duel for the lead, inched clear on the hill, fought back in the stretch and weakened some late. REAL DEAL APPEAL dueled between horses then stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. COLE COLE chased between rivals then a bit off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the hill, continued along the rail in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. NEIL HEALY broke a bit slowly, settled out from the inside, angled in some on the hill, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. BLUE CHEROKEE dueled between horses then stalked just off the rail, was between foes again in midstretch and weakened. BENEDICT AUDREY settled off the inside, went three deep then four wide leaving the hill, stumbled exiting the dirt crossing and lost the rider, then was vanned off. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident into the stretch before ruling BENEDICT AUDREY was the cause of his own trouble. Rail on hill at zero.
