Footnotes

FAVORITE FUNTIME stalked the leaders outside on the backstretch, ranged up four wide on the turn, gained the lead and inched clear, then proved best under some urging and steady handling. JEWELED PIRATE wide early, chased off the rail, came wide into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch and held second. GOT THE MEMO was well placed off the rail early, angled in for the turn, lacked room and steadied briefly nearing the stretch, came around a rival, then put in an inside bid in the drive. SHE'S A SENSATION unhurried outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and improved position. QUEEN CREEK close up off the rail tracking the pace, bid three deep between horses on the turn but weakened in the stretch. MOMENT TO REMEMBER raced wide throughout and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STAR'S MILLENNIUM bumped at the start, was outrun off the rail early, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. CATHEDRAL BELLE was unhurried early, angled in and saved ground to no avail. FAVORITE MISS dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and between horses on the turn, dropped back and came out into the stretch and weakened. RUNON ROUGE was without early speed, saved ground to the stretch, came out and was not a threat. ESTEE flashed good early speed and dueled inside until nearing the stretch, then weakened. CLASSYWON settled outside on the backstretch, went between horses on the turn and had no response.
