Footnotes

LASER POINT close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside a rival past midstretch, gained the lead under urging and inched away. HAMMURABI pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and gained the place while between foes late. BENEZIT settled a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch, rallied under steady urging until the rider lost the whip nearing the sixteenth pole and just got the show. AQUICKSTING threw his head at the start but broke alertly, had speed off the rail then angled in, inched away on the first turn, set the pace inside, held on well to deep stretch and was outfinished late for a minor award. RON BOB stalked inside then a bit off the rail, split horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TROUBLETIMESTHREE angled in and raced unhurried along the inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. GOLD STOCK pulled his way along outside a rival, stalked off the rail or between horses, came out into the stretch, drifted in some and weakened. TAP TAP I WIN between foes early, chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn and did not rally.
