SO SHE DANCES chased outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch, rallied under some urging to the lead in late stretch and inched clear. FAST MOKA TOO sped to the early lead, set the pace just off the rail, angled in leaving the hill and held on well to deep stretch but could not contain the winner. VALERIA chased off the rail then moved up between horses on the hill, loomed a threat behind the pacesetter in midstretch but could not get by that one to the wire. DYNAMIC DIVA saved ground chasing the pace, was in a bit tight off heels leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. FLY SOLO pulled her way between horses to stalk the early pace, angled in and tracked inside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. BURSQUEL stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and also weakened. PRIMAL DESIRE broke a bit slowly then steadied sharply when squeezed to drop well back, settled just off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
