SHE'S GRAND was unhurried down the hill, swung out in upper stretch rallied gamely under urging on the far outside to prove best. GRENY dueled inside down the hill, spurted clear in the stretch but could not hold off the winner. AMERICAN AFFAIR, was close up between rivals to the stretch and continued willingly for third. HOLY NINER also raced between horses down the hill, came out a bit for the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MY MEDALLION was outrun to the stretch, swung out and found her best stride too late. SPONTANEOUS raced with striking distance three deep down the hill and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. STORMY FLYER, well placed outside to the stretch, loomed outside in midstretch, then did not rally late. DOREMIFASOLASIDO was off a bit slowly and saved ground to no avail. DANZA PERDIDA dueled three deep down the hill, drifted far wide into the stretch, weakened, then collapsed after being unsaddled and was vanned off. OUR ENGLAND'S ROSE saved ground throughout and was in a bit tight in midstretch. ATONE, vied for command between horses down the hill and weakened. QUICKLEY DONE was outrun, angled in down the hill, then drifted far wide into the stretch.
