LITTLE BOSS CHICK sped to a slim early lead and dueled a bit off the rail then inside, inched away under urging in midstretch and pulled clear. FEEL THE RUSH dueled between horses then outside the winner on the turn and into the stretch and was second best. PREVENTION unhurried along the inside early, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. PIPPETTE bobbed at the start, prompted the pace between horses then stalked, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. KAITLYN'S LIGHT forced the pace three deep between horses then stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch and also weakened. KRIS' SIS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, angled in some for the turn and did not rally. MORGANESE between foes early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside and weakened in the stretch. RED NECK GAL broke in the air and slowly, saved ground and was outrun. HEMET HUMOR five wide early, prompted the pace four wide then stalked outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and gave way.
