REGALLY READY had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear crossing the dirt, drifted out some under left handed urging in the final strides but held gamely. CAMP VICTORY a bit slow to begin, chased inside, came off the rail in deep stretch and surged alongside the winner late. SUPREME SUMMIT broke inward and slowly, settled inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and finished willingly to get up for the show three deep on the wire. COMPARI had speed three deep then stalked off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and continued willingly but could not quite summon the necessary late kick. GALLANT SON chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and split horses on the wire. VICTORY PETE dueled between horses then outside the winner, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
