**Footnotes**

SIBERIAN HEART chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up three deep on the line. MARRYMEONEMORETIME stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out some into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch and continued willingly between horses late. FREQUENT FAME pulled a bit and stalked inside, came out some in upper stretch then angled in and bid along the fence, took a short lead past midstretch and also continued gamely to the end. LISA LULU sped to the early lead, angled in after the right hand curve and set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back between horses in the stretch and weakened some late. NOTHING TO FEAR settled off the pace inside, came out a bit crossing the dirt then angled back in and could not offer the necessary late kick. HOT CITIZEN chased outside a rival down the hill, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DISLITLELITEOMINE stalked the pace outside a rival, came out leaving the hill and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MERRYTAGIO settled off the rail then angled in on the hill and saved ground to no avail. IDA OF MARCH was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, drifted four wide into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
