MEGAHERTZ (GB) lagged back inside, moved up off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and closed determinedly under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. NADESZHDA (GB) chased outside a rival, bid three deep to gain command on the second turn, inched clear in the stretch and continued willingly but could not quite match the winner late. HOH BUZZARD (IRE) chased a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn, angled in entering the stretch and bested the rest. URAIB (IRE) allowed to settle a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MOSCOW BURNING drifted out into the stretch the first time, angled in and chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. MIDWIFE pulled her way to the early lead and angled in, opened up into the first turn, widened leaving the backstretch, began to shorten stride on the second turn, steadied when rivals went past a quarter mile out and weakened. ASK FOR THE MOON (FR) off a bit slowly and awkwardly, angled in and saved ground to no avail.
