GLAMOUR CAT pulled her way to the early lead, angled in then came out into the backstretch, opened a commanding advantage into the second turn, was pushed along a bit in upper stretch but won clear under a hold. BLUE CAY pulled along the inside chasing the winner, came out into the stretch and gained the place. MYSTERIOUS PEACE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and bested the others. HIGH SOCIETY drifted out into the first turn, chased outside a rival, was between foes leaving the second turn and lacked the needed response. MYSTICAL CAPER allowed to settle toward the inside then off the rail, circled five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. ELEMENT K. off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and improved position. FRESH HOT BUNS chased outside a rival, was three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. FASTRIP chased outside a rival then between foes, came out into the stretch and did not rally. HOLLYWOODSETRIGHT taken a bit off the rail early, angled in on the first turn and chased inside, fell back some on the second turn and weakened. PROLLY chased outside, went four wide into the second turn, dropped back and angled in on that bend and gave way.
