**Footnotes**

IF YOU KNEW SUSIE chased between horses then outside a rival, moved up a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and pulled clear under urging. AFLEET BREEZE three deep early, settled off the rail, angled in and moved up inside on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. LISA LULU saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and just missed second. MUSICAL GRACE stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead into the stretch, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. POCATELLO WILD KAT chased between foes then outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. SWEET PATRICIA sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, fought back to midstretch, then weakened. SENIOR SECURITY hopped in a bit of a slow start, settled just off the rail, came out on the backstretch, angled out again into the stretch and did not rally. BAD BAD GABY stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the backstretch, dropped back between foes midway on the second turn and gave way.
