Footnotes

JUNIPER PASS chased outside then alongside a rival, came out leaving the final turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under some left handed urging and got up on the wire. IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) stalked a bit off the rail then inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied between horses past midstretch to put a head in front late but was caught on the line. CELTIC NEW YEAR stalked the early pace then bid alongside a rival to gain an advantage, duelled inside POWER SERIES then let that one slip away in the stretch the first time, bid alongside that rival on the clubhouse turn, stalked again on the backstretch, bid outside that foe a quarter mile out then fell back some in the stretch, bid again in deep stretch, was between horses late and continued willingly to the wire. QUINDICI MAN saved ground stalking the pace, bid along the rail past midstretch and also went on gamely to the end. FALCON ROCK (IRE) pulled between horses then settled a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and finished well but was outkicked late. POWER SERIES broke inward and a bit slowly, pulled his way along four wide then took the lead outside a rival and angled in leaving the hill, set the pace inside, inched away in the stretch the first time and again on the backstretch, fought back leaving the second turn, slipped away again in the stretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and weakened some late. HAIMISH HY chased off the rail then outside on the hill, pulled his way between horses in the stretch the first time, settled inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ROMP (ARG) angled in and pulled a bit on the hill then saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and could not offer the necessary response in the

drive. DAHOUD (NZ) took the early lead and showed the way through a quarter mile in :24.79 seconds, dropped back leaving the hill, chased outside a rival then three deep on the clubhouse turn, continued alongside a foe on the backstretch, came out on the final turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. Rail on hill at zero.
