VAN BRIT stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up on the second turn, took a short lead in the stretch and inched away late under urging. LIVING OUR DREAM went up four wide to the early lead then angled in, set the pace along the fence, fought back on the second turn and through the stretch but could not quite match the winner late. HAMEILDAEME (GB) chased outside a rival then inside into the second turn, came out into the stretch, was three wide in midstretch and bested the others. ROLLERSKATES saved ground stalking the pace throughout and could not offer the necessary late kick. PRYTANIA angled in and settled off the pace inside, continued along the rail into the second turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. BELLA ROJA stalked outside a rival then off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. SHES A LUCKY WAGER between horses early, tracked the leader outside a rival, dropped back and angled in on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
