Footnotes

SHADOW OF ILLINOIS chased off the rail, inched forward outside leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch, bid outside GOLDEN ARROW and had the rider lose the whip in midstretch but proved best under some hand slapping and strong handling. GERONIMO (CHI) chased inside then between foes leaving the hill, awaited room behind rivals crossing the dirt, came out into the stretch and just got the place. GOLDEN ARROW pulled early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the hill to gain the lead in the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong and just lost second. LAZZERI forced the early pace inside then stalked along the rail, came off the fence in the stretch and lacked the needed response. MCCANN'S MOJAVE had good early speed and dueled between horses, battled inside leaving the hill and weakened in the stretch. ROYAL PRICE (GER) dueled three deep then outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and also weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
