Footnotes

BOURBON BAY a step slow to begin, went between horses then settled outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch, rallied to the front under urging in deep stretch and held sway. UNUSUAL SUSPECT settled toward the inside, saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and closed willingly late. SKELLYTOWN chased inside, came out on the final turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead, inched away briefly in midstretch, drifted in and fought back through the final furlong and held third. FALCON ROCK (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, came out into stretch, angled in again and bid inside in midstretch but was outfinished. ROMP (ARG) unhurried inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the last turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. TAP IT LIGHT tugged his way to the early lead then relinquished command after taking the field through a quarter mile in :24.83 seconds, chased just off the rail, bid alongside the leader a quarter mile out to regain command, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. YODELEN DAN settled outside a rival, went three deep on the final turn and into the stretch, then drifted in and lacked a further response. MUHANNAK (IRE) chased toward the inside then a bit off the rail, dropped back between horses into the final turn and had little left thereafter. PRINCESS TAYLOR (GB) angled in and chased outside a rival, continued alongside a foe into the stretch and did not rally. STALINGRAD pulled between horses then tugged his way to the front on the hill, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled briefly a quarter mile out and gave way once headed nearing the stretch. Rail on hill at zero.
