SPEAK IN PASSING stalked off the rail then outside on the hill, came four wide into the stretch, bid five wide in midstretch and gamely prevailed. SPINELESSJELLYFISH cut the corner at the right hand curve then angled in down the hill, bid along the rail in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. ROCKY BAR quickly sprinted clear, set the pace off the rail, drifted out into the stretch, was fought back between foes in midstretch and also went on well to the end. THUNDER BULLET pulled early, cut the corner at the right hand curve then stalked three deep, continued outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and was outfinished. ECSTATIC stalked between horses then a bit off the rail down the hill, split rivals with a bid in midstretch but also was outfinished. LOS SOLANO (GB) unhurried and angled in on the hill, swung out crossing the dirt and found his best stride late. CANNY FLY (AUS) angled right early and chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LINE RIDER close up stalking the pace inside, dropped back some leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and weakened.
