Footnotes

CROWNING ESSENCE unhurried toward the inside on the backstretch, split horses on the turn, came out some in the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. KALOOKAN SARGE stalked a bit off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch to gain the lead, drifted in despite left handed urging and was caught late. BIGUM settled inside, split horses into the stretch, came out in midstretch and finished well. BUBBA BROKE ME dueled between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, found the rail in the final furlong and weakened. SHAKIN' JAKE had good early speed off the rail then angled in and dueled inside and weakened in the final furlong. IT WAS THE DUKES prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch and much of the turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and also weakened. SIZZLING PHONE chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and gave way. EL JACAL angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and had little left.
