Footnotes

OUTPERFORM chased inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch, rallied under a strong hand ride to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and proved best under a long hold late. CHICAGO HERO had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear in the stretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. DUTCH COURAGE dueled four wide on the backstretch, stalked three deep on the turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for the place. BRAWLER vied for command between horses then stalked a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PLAYIN THE ODDS turned his head, broke a bit slowly and bobbed, went up between horses to press the pace, stalked between foes on the turn and also weakened in the final furlong. TAYLOR MARINI settled off the rail then went between horses into the turn, continued alongside a foe on the bend and lacked a rally. POCKET PRINCE chased a bit off the fence then angled to the inside on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. BESSEMER VICTORY stalked outside then three deep into the turn, dropped back off the inside on the bend and gave way.
