Footnotes

LAST TANGO (IRE) stalked the pace along the inside, came out in upper stretch, bid outside the pacesetter, took a short lead past the eighth pole and proved best under urging. JALISCO (IRE) saved ground tracking the leaders, waited a bit into the stretch, got through along the rail in the drive but was outfinished. I'M THE BUSINESS (NZ) took the early lead under a hold outside a rival, angled to the inside in the run to the first turn, dueled inside, inched away into the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive, could not match the top pair but held third. ADDICTED was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ARROW ANGEL (NZ) between horses early, also chased outside a rival, angled three deep into the stretch and also could not offer the necessary response. SINGLE HONOUR (GB) four wide early, angled in and dueled outside a rival until nearing the stretch and weakened. BEL AIR BELLE off a bit slowly, pulled her way between horses early, chased three deep, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
