Footnotes

SIPHON HONEY had good early speed between horses then angled in and dueled along the rail, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under some urging and good handling. SOPHISTICATEDBLUFF stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, angled in past midstretch and gained the place. AZURE SPRING dueled three deep then outside the winner to the stretch, could not match that one in the drive and lost second late. IF BY MAGIC stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed response. GEMS OF WISDOM forced or stalked the pace inside, dropped back leaving the turn and weakened. CAROLDEAN chased between horses then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and did not rally. JILL MCGILL stumbled at the start, went up between rivals early then three deep on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. GENTLEMEN'S GUEST saved ground off the pace and was not a factor. SHOWTIME EXPRESS off a bit slowly, pulled her way up between horses on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and had little left.
