GAME CHARMER stalked inside then bid for the lead on the backstretch, put a head in front a half mile out, inched away into the turn, responded when challenged leaving the turn, fought back along the fence under urging in the stretch, inched away again in deep stretch and held gamely. ITSPHUN stumbled at the start, went between foes then chased off the rail, came out into the stretch and finished well, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. MIRACLE MERGER stalked outside a rival on the backstretch, bid alongside the winner on the turn and through the stretch, could not match that one late and was edged for the place. DEPISTRY stalked outside then three deep on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and weakened. KALOOKAN DESERT broke alertly then dropped back off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground thereafter and was not a threat. WARRENS CHINA DOLL had speed between horses then set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled alongside the winner leaving the backstretch, was between foes nearing the turn, angled in and stalked inside on the bend, dropped back, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and weakened.
