LUMBERYARD JACK stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched clear and held under some urging. QUAINLY angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was four wide in midstretch and continued willingly to best the rest. FALCON ROCK (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, waited momentarily then split foes in midstretch and continued on well along the inside to edge a rival for the show. ANTIDOTE pulled a bit and stalked inside, bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch and second turn and between horses leaving that turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. MYHORSEOFCOURSE three deep on the hill, settled off the rail chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ERBEIA was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. KESSABTSI took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
