Footnotes

MALABAR GOLD angled in and stalked the leader inside, came out into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to collar that one late. ASTONISHED (GB) quickly sped to the front and angled right, cut the corner at the right hand curve then angled in on a clear advantage, set the pace inside and held on gamely but was caught in the final stages. NUCLEAR DEBATE pulled between horses then off the rail on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and finished well for third. CASEY GRIFFIN chased along the inside, came out into the stretch, was crowded off heels in midstretch, came out again and put in a late bid. SWEPT OVERBOARD was in a good position chasing the leader along the inside to the stretch, remained inside and lacked the needed late response. DEVINE WIND close up stalking outside a rival early, fell back a bit down the hill, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. MACWARD between horses early, settled outside a rival, angled out into the stretch and did not rally. STRATTON (IRE) pulled his way along between horses chasing the pace and also lacked the needed rally. LAKE WILLIAM was in a good striking position chasing three deep down the hill and weakened.
