CALIFORNIA FLAG sped to the early lead, set the pace on a clear lead off the rail then inside down the hill and into the stretch and remained clear in the drive under left handed urging. SAYIF (IRE) pulled his way along just off the fence then angled in and stalked inside on the hill, continued along the rail in the stretch and just held second. COMPARI squeezed a bit at the start, chased off the rail then moved up between foes, stalked alongside a rival down the hill and into the stretch and saved the show. IRISH ART chased outside then three deep on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and was edged for third. VICTORY PETE went up inside to stalk the pace, steadied in a bit tight off heels into the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SUPREME SUMMIT broke a bit slowly, cut the corner at the right hand curve then settled off the rail, angled in leaving the hill, found the fence in the stretch and lacked a rally. AIN'T NO OTHER stalked three deep then off the rail leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
