### Footnotes

BET ON VICTOR stalked outside then alongside a rival, went up three deep into the turn, bid alongside the pacesetter, took the lead in upper stretch, inched clear past midstretch and held under urging. OBSESS saved ground chasing the pace throughout and went up along the rail to gain the place. CYCLOMETER four wide early, stalked outside then alongside a rival, was between foes into the turn, came out into the stretch and held third. JOHN SCOTT between foes early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, was between horses again in midstretch and was edged for the show. CLOSE TO THE EDGE settled off the rail, went up four wide into the turn, continued three deep, came out four wide into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. INDUSTRY LEADER chased a bit off the rail, split horses into the turn, came out a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. FLIGHTOFALIFETIME sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled on the turn and until past midstretch and weakened. DA RULER pulled his way along outside on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. CHAPMAN'S PEAK between horses early, chased a bit off the rail, dropped back in the stretch and weakened.
