Footnotes

ON THE ACORN (GB) chased inside or a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the final turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and pulled clear under left handed urging. SWEET RETURN (GB) took the early lead, went a quarter mile in :25.89, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and last turn, fought back in the stretch, could not quite match the winner in the final furlong but gamely held second. FITZ FLAG (ARG) broke a bit slowly, chased inside, came out into the stretch, swung out for room behind foes in midstretch and split rivals late for third. EMBOSSED (IRE) stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch and final turn, fought back between rivals through the stretch and continued willingly. ONE OFF (GB) bobbled at the start, settled outside a rival then inside, continued a bit off the rail on the backstretch, swung out into the stretch and found his best stride late four wide on the line. BOULE D'OR (IRE) had the rider lose the whip in the initial strides, settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and did not rally. ICY RIDGE (IRE) drifted wide crossing the dirt, stalked off the rail or outside, bid three deep on the backstretch and most of the last turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
