Footnotes

BENBA sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, dueled from the rail on the backstretch and second turn, shook off a rival in the stretch, kicked clear under some urging and proved best. DANCER HUMOR pulled his way along inside and was in a bit close off heels on the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. WARREN'S CLIFF S. angled in and tugged early, stalked inside, moved up along the rail into the stretch and was narrowly edged for second. DREAMALOT unhurried along the inside to the stretch, remained on the rail and improved position. RED MAN RUN stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid between foes on the backstretch, dueled outside the winner on the second turn, fell back some into the stretch, was between rivals in midstretch and weakened. DR. SPIN chased between horses then outside a rival on the backstretch, split foes leaving the second turn and lacked a rally. TENKILLER KID stalked three deep then outside a rival, bid three wide on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn, drifted out into the stretch and weakened.
