Footnotes

TALE BE TOLD chased off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn and into the stretch, angled inward in deep stretch, bid along the inside to gain the lead under left handed urging late and gamely prevailed. SHERIFF HUTTON dueled between horses then inside on the turn, inched away in the stretch,

fought back between foes in deep stretch and was edged. RUNNING WATER broke a bit slowly, moved up inside to chase the pace, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and finished well three deep on the line. MARY HELEN'S STORM prompted the pace three deep then outside the runner-up on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PATRIOTIC LION stalked between horses then three deep on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. NEIL HEALY chased between foes, went between horses again on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. FLY HIGH saved ground chasing the pace, steadied and came out off heels early on the turn, split rivals on the bend then angled back in entering the stretch and did not rally. CARRYTHETEAM a bit slow to begin, settled outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. SCATMAN BLUES stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and weakened. JERRY FRANCO went up inside to duel for the lead, fell back on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. DANI'S BIRTHDAY sent between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail then fell back inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
