ACTION THIS DAY three deep early, dropped back unhurried off the rail, moved up outside a rival on the second turn, split rivals in midstretch then bid between foes and gamely prevailed under urging. NATIVE APPROVAL broke outward, chased three deep, bid outside foes past midstretch and went willingly to the end. COURAGEOUS ACT stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, took a short lead in midstretch and also continued on gamely to the wire. THAT'S AN OUTRAGE stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn, bid along the rail in the stretch but could not match the top three late. DRAMATIC COPY sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled between horses in midstretch, steadied while beginning to weaken and dropped back. QUIET CASH was in a good position chasing between horses then a bit off the inside, dropped back on the second turn and also weakened. REAL QUIET HEATH saved ground chasing the pace, dropped well back leaving the backstretch and gave way.
