STAKES Yellow Ribbon S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$500 each if made on or before Thursday, September 4, 2003 or by supplementary nomination of \$10,000 by Friday, September 26. All horses shall pay \$5,000 to start with \$500,000 guaranteed, of which \$300,000 to the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth and \$10,000 to fifth. Three-Year-Olds: 118 lbs. Older: 123 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. This race will not be divided. If the number exceeds fourteen (14), preference will be determined in the following order: First preference will be given to graded or group winners in 2003. Second preference will be given to those horses with the highest total earnings in 2003. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATION OF \$10,000: CELLAMARE (FR).

Footnotes

TATES CREEK saved ground stalking the pace, awaited room off heels when blocked on the second turn and into the stretch, bulled through between horses in midstretch, gained the lead and held gamely under urging. MUSICAL CHIMES settled a bit off the rail after breaking slowly, came out into the stretch and closed willingly to gain the place at the wire. CRAZY ENSIGN (ARG) a bit wide on the dirt crossing, stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside a foe leaving the second turn, gained the advantage in upper stretch, battled three deep in midstretch, could not quite match the winner and lost second late. MAGIC MISSION (GB) a bit slow to begin, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, angled back inward and was outfinished. RED RIOJA (IRE) unhurried inside for a mile, came out in upper stretch and improved position. ADALGISA pulled her way along outside early, stalked alongside a rival, went three deep into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CASSIS took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, battled along the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch, steadied in tight when the winner went by in midstretch and also weakened. CELLAMARE (FR) hopped onto the dirt crossing, pulled her way along between horses chasing the early pace, continued outside a rival on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and had little left in the stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident between the winner and CASSIS in midstretch but made no change when they ruled the original order of finished was not affected.
