REGULUS washy at the gate, stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, fought back under urging, drifted out some and was inching away late. PLANET SUNSHINE pulled between foes then drifted out into the first turn, stalked outside then just off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the winner in the drive, was floated out a bit and could not quite match that one late. BROTHER FRANCIS a bit slow to begin, was fanned five wide into the first turn, stalked outside, came three wide into the stretch, drifted in some and edged a rival late for third. DISTORT THIS pulled three deep then took the lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch, weakened in the final furlong and lost the show late. RIVETING REASON settled a bit off the rail, split horses into the stretch and was not a threat. EL GATO MALO saved ground chasing the pace throughout and had little left in the stretch. THEY CALL HIM EL fanned four wide into the first turn, settled outside or off the rail, continued outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gave way in the drive and was eased late.
