Footnotes

IT'S AINE had good early speed off the rail then angled in, dueled inside, fought back in the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. A LITTLE LUCKIER stalked three deep then dropped back some, moved up outside a rival into the turn then just off the inside on the bend, came out in midstretch and finished willingly. FLAMBOYANCE dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn, fought back outside the winner in the stretch and continued gamely to the wire. FLAXEN MAIDEN chased a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn and into the stretch and bested the rest. DIAMOND FLUSH settled inside, went outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch and improved position but was not a serious threat. CANALASSO had good early speed and stalked three deep then outside into the turn, angled in off the inside leaving the turn and weakened. TRIBAL RAIN stalked early then bid between foes a half mile

out, dueled three deep on the turn and weakened in the stretch. REAL BRIGHT BOOTS pulled her way along to press the pace three deep then four wide leaving the backstretch and into the turn, stalked outside leaving the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. KEVIN'S KOOL KAT settled off the rail then outside a rival, continued outside on the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and was not a factor. UNUSUAL SENSATION swerved in sharply to be away behind the field, moved up outside a rival then a bit off the rail but had little left for the stretch. CLOUD RACER sent along inside to stalk the pace, pulled under a hold leaving the backstretch, was in a bit tight into the turn, dropped back, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
