DOWNHILL TURF FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. FREE nominations close Friday, September 20. All horses pay \$350 to start with \$70,000 added. The added monies and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$25,000 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of two races other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter, 4 lbs.; \$25,000 since July 4, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). Highweights preferred, followed by Graded Stake Winners, followed by Graded Stakes placed horses, followed by highest earners. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of entries.

Footnotes

PONTCHATRAIN stalked outside a rival then between foes leaving the hill, came three deep into the stretch, gained a short lead, kicked clear under left handed urging while drifting in and proved best. TRIBAL SPY stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the hill, came out a bit into the stretch, lacked room when in tight off heels between horses in midstretch, came out some again and went willingly between foes for the place. WARREN'S VENEDA a bit slow to begin, chased just off the rail then inside, bid along the fence in the stretch and held third. JUDY IN DISGUISE (GB) chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch and put in a late bid for a minor award between foes. ZIA ZIA ZIA had good early speed and duelled inside, battled between horses in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but gave ground grudgingly to the others. MOULIN DE MOUGINE chased outside then four wide

leaving the hill and into the stretch and put in a late bid for a minor award outside. HEIR KITTY chased off the rail then between horses leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and went between foes nearing the wire. INCLUDE THE AUSSIE saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. UNUSUAL WAY prompted the pace between horses then outside a rival, battled between foes in midstretch and weakened late. TRAVESURA settled off the pace three deep then outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LILBOURNE ELIZA (IRE) pulled her way between horses, dropped back a bit off the rail leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and did not rally. HAIL MARY forced the pace three deep then stalked outside leaving the hill, came four wide into the stretch and weakened.
