SECRET COMPASS stalked toward the inside then outside a rival, moved up alongside a foe on the second turn then off the rail, came out some into the stretch, loomed behind the runner-up in midstretch then gamely wore down that rival under left handed urging. SHE'S A TIGER tugged her way along to stalk the pace outside a rival then bid three deep on the backstretch to duel for the lead, inched clear into the second turn, continued just off the rail into and through the stretch and held on gamely but was edged late. FASCINATING chased inside then a bit off the rail, moved up under urging outside a rival on the second turn then off the inside leaving that turn, came out into the stretch and also went on willingly to the wire. HARLINGTON'S ROSE had good early speed and angled in, duelled inside on the backstretch, dropped back into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. AWESOME BABY also had good early speed and stalked off the rail, bid between foes to duel for the lead, also fell back on the second turn, angled in and weakened. BELLE OF THE FLEET away a bit awkwardly, was fanned out into the first turn then settled off the rail or outside a rival, angled in leaving the second turn and had little left for the stretch. ANTIQUITY pulled her way along and drifted out some into the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
