HULA QUEEN bumped at the start, settled outside, came far wide into the stretch and closed gamely under urging to win going away. DESERT LADY (IRE) chased between horses down the hill but was in a bit tight leaving the hill, came out and gained the place late. ECUDIENNE sped between rivals to the early lead and dueled outside a foe, got clear leaving the hill, drifted out into the stretch and held third. JANINE ROSE, steadied when squeezed at the start, trailed off the rail and put in a late bid. VALID LEADER, stalked outside a rival, drifted out into the stretch and weakened. MISS HOT SALSA steadied at the right hand curve, then angled in, came out for the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ROYAL SHYNESS (GB) chased between rivals down the hill and weakened. SEATTLE CARLA was well placed three deep down the hill, came far wide into the stretch and also weakened. A. P. ASSAY bobbed at the start, sprinted up inside to force the pace, steadied sharply down the hill to drop back and weakened. THERESA'S TIZZY angled in and vied for the lead inside, dropped back leaving the hill, hopped crossing the dirt and had little left for the stretch. HOLY HOPE (BRZ) broke slowly, went up inside to a contending position, dropped back on the hill and steadied off heels, then drifted out in the stretch.
