Footnotes

BYRAMA (GB) chased between horses then outside a rival, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead in late stretch and prevailed. CHARM THE MAKER broke a bit slowly and was crowded, settled outside a rival then just off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, angled inward nearing midstretch, split rivals to gain the lead and held on well but was edged late. STARRY SKIES unhurried and angled in off the rail down the hill, came out in the stretch and closed willingly. KILLER GRACES chased between horses, bid between foes in the drive and was outfinished. SMOKIN' GREY squeezed back at the start, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and finished with interest. COUP DE COEUR sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened. LASSO FROM EL PASO stalked off the rail then three deep on the hill, was fanned five wide into the stretch and did not rally. KOKO LOCA (IRE) between horses early, angled in and settled inside, saved ground down the hill and lacked the needed rally. WILD TRUFFLES chased outside then three deep, came out leaving the hill, was fanned six wide into the stretch

and could not offer the necessary response. LOVE TALE (GB) settled off the inside, angled in leaving the hill and did not rally. MADOFFWITHTHEMONEY had early speed then stalked off the rail, was in a bit tight between foes nearing midstretch and weakened. VIVA CARINA (ARG) broke slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, bid inside in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. Rail on hill at zero.
